## Policy T4

## Transport Statements, Assessments and Plans

- 1. New development proposals must be accompanied by a Transport Assessment where required, in accordance with the threshold criteria set out in Kent County Council's latest Guidance on Transport Assessments and Travel Plans, or otherwise justified by site-specific factors such as existing traffic issues or limited transport infrastructure. Where appropriate, a Transport Statement may be submitted instead. All assessments must consider both the individual and cumulative impacts of the development on the transport network.
- 2. Where thresholds are met including for major developments, proposals generating significant traffic, or sites with known transport constraints a Travel Plan must also be provided. This should monitor mode share and include a package of measures to promote sustainable travel and achieve agreed targets.
- 3. Where Transport Statements, Assessments or Plans identify the need for mitigation measures, these may be secured through planning conditions or legal agreements, including Section 106 obligations.
