

Sevenoaks Town East to West Walking, Wheeling & Cycling Route

Overview


Sevenoaks District Council and Kent County Council are working together to deliver a new walking, wheeling and cycling route that connects the east and west of Sevenoaks town, allowing residents to travel by safe and sustainable means as an alternative to using their cars for short journeys.

The funding to deliver the route has already been secured, and we have been working on the design of the route, which has been influenced by the consultation undertaken in Summer 2023. This showed strong overall support for the route (61%), but raised some concerns with the Bradbourne Park Road and St James's Road sections. We have revised the design to overcome the issues raised through the consultation and are now asking for your views on the revised sections of the route, so that we can finalise it ready for construction later this year. **The consultation will be open from 10 May 2024 for a period of three weeks.** All comments must be submitted no later than 11:59pm on **03 June 2024**.



Route Overview

The Sevenoaks Town walking, wheeling and cycling route takes you through the heart of the town, connecting Riverhead to Wilderness.

We have revised the design to overcome the issues raised through the Summer 2023 consultation and are now asking for your views on the revised sections of the route, so that we can finalise it ready for construction later this year.


The revised route makes use of Cavendish Avenue, Oakdene Road and Bradbourne Vale Road instead of Clockhouse Lane, Bradbourne Park Road and St James Road. The remainder of the route remains the same as previously consulted on.



Revised Route Section

The revised route makes use of Cavendish Avenue, Oakdene Road and Bradbourne Vale Road (instead of Clockhouse Lane, Bradbourne Park Road and St James's Road).

Seven on-street car parking spaces will be lost at the junction of Bradbourne Road and Bradbourne Vale Road, however these will be relocated on Bradbourne Vale Road. An additional six on-street car parking spaces will also be provided along Bradbourne Vale Road.


